

2009 LCCMR Allocation Recommendations to the 2009 Minnesota Legislature

*In response to the 2009 proposal process, 146 proposals requesting a total of approximately \$105.3 million were received. Approximately \$26.1 million is available for 2009 funding (\$25.6 million - Environment and Natural Resources Trust Fund; \$66,000 - Great Lakes Protection Account; \$400,000 - Land and Water Conservation Fund). After full consideration of all proposals received, on 12/10/08 the LCCMR made final allocation recommendations for 33 appropriations, some of which combine and/or incorporate multiple proposals from those received. These recommendations ranged from full funding for the full project and dollar amount requested to partial funding for specific project elements and partial dollar amount requested. Project managers of proposals recommended for funding will be contacted individually regarding the parameters of their project's allocation recommendation.
